

ROLE OF DPOs IN CBR

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DPO OBJECTIVES

- To advocate for, and demand, all the rights and quality of life for PWDs
- To promote PWDs' empowerment in order to take control of their own development
- To promote social inclusion as advocated in the UN Standard Rules, Salamanca Statement and other international instruments

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COMPONENTS OF CBR (1)

- Creating a positive attitude towards people with disabilities
- Provision of functional rehabilitation services
- Provision of education and training opportunities
- Creation of micro and macro income generation opportunities

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COMPONENTS OF CBR (2)

- Provision of care facilities
- Prevention of the causes of disabilities
- Management, monitoring and evaluation

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IMPLEMENTERS OF CBR

CBR is implemented through a combined effort of disabled people themselves, their families and communities, and appropriate health, education, vocational and social services.

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ROLE OF DPOs IN CBR

- To lobby and advocate for inclusion of PWDs at community and national level
- To carry out activities in line with their objectives at local community level
- To sensitise and mobilise communities
- To participate in personnel training for CBR
- To serve as role-models in the community
